





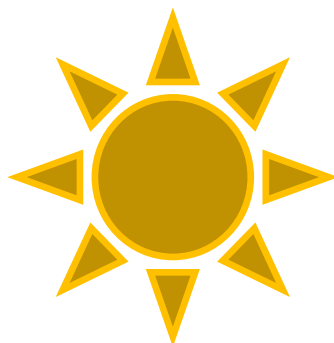
NATURE DETECTIVE
